



Free Disposal at Benson Valley Next Week

FRANKFORT, Ky. (April 18, 2019) – The Franklin County Spring Clean is the week of April 22-27. As part of the clean-up, Franklin County residents can dispose at Benson Valley Landfill at no cost on Thursday, April 25 and Friday, April 26. On Saturday, April 27, residents will need a landfill voucher (franklincounty.ky.gov/trash-vouchers) in order to dispose for free. The following guidelines apply:

- Residents will receive one free disposal during the Spring Clean, per household, per day
- Load size is limited to the bed of a pickup truck or a single axle trailer
- Contractors are not eligible for free disposal at the Landfill
- Heavy construction debris, including shingles and concrete, tires, and white-good appliances are excluded from free disposal
- All loads must be tarped to prevent litter when hauling to the landfill
- Residents must present a valid Frankfort / Franklin County driver's license
