



Landfill Infrastructure Project Nearing Completion

FRANKFORT, Ky. (Apr. 29, 2020) – While the current public health crisis is disrupting many things in daily life, our team has worked hard to maintain normal operations at Benson Valley Landfill. This includes our continued progress on the landfill gas system expansion we announced earlier this year. As part of our efforts to manage the Landfill safely and responsibly, and to control the potential for off-site odor, we have had crews on-site over the past several weeks installing additional landfill gas wells and supporting infrastructure.

Since late February, our team has installed 19 new vertical landfill gas wells to collect and control more landfill gas at the site. All of the new wells are now online and actively collecting landfill gas. Along with the wells, we are installing more than 2.5 miles of supporting infrastructure so that the landfill gas collection system continues to operate efficiently and effectively. We are finishing installation of four new horizontal landfill gas wells to further bolster the system's collection capacity, and we anticipate completing all of the existing work by mid-May.
